Al Huelga studied Photographic Art at the Academy of Art College in San Francisco and has been taking underwater and land photographs professionally for nearly 40 yeas. He uses 35mm and medium format film, digital cameras and video equipment for his work.

His photography has received high honors in a number of underwater and topside photography competitions over the years. He has competed in the European Diving Certification Organization's (Confédération Mondiale des Activités Subaquatiques, CMAS) Underwater Photography World Championships representing the U.S.A. in Cuba, Spain and Norway and was among the top 10 finalists in Cuba's 1992 World Championships.
