Very powerful image, composition and framing all work nicely.

Great colors in the sailboats, the young child yellow rain coat really adds to the overall image. The white sign on the shed pulls your eyes Away from the subject, crop this out for s much stronger image.

3. F22 Raptor Performing At The Sacramento International Air Show 2010 Jet is framed within the clouds gives excellent depth to an otherwise static Shot.

## 4. Installation of chimney cap

The shot could be better at a distance, showing the entire side of the house would convey the more hazards than with such a tight image.

# 5. Judging Austin Bantams

Overcast days are great for shooting cars, it shows all the highlights. I would try to shoot the car more from the side, still showing the rear tire detail. This would stack the car and judges into a tighter group.

# 6. Marilyn watching newlyweds

A lot going on in the frame, at that distance the newlyweds are almost lost. Get much closer and have Marilyn almost as a backdrop.

- 7. Mika Kallio Goes Over the High Side Red Bull Moto GP 2011 Good timing, a big hurt waits ahead. Good work, worth the wait.
- 8. Motorcycle Stunt At the Watsonville Fly-In 2010
  Nice framing, bike has pleanty of open space to drive into, good balance.

A this distance the newlyweds are lost in a busy shot, bring them much closer. The newsstand would give you a Norman Rockwell feel.

Car could be more visable, look at angles not common, maybe shoot From the field or closer to car.

Easy to pick out the owner. On lookers help frame the car and owner nicely.

Nice image, nice tight shot brings the rescue divers work out in detail.

Lots of action, hard to miss with that monster.

#### 14. Street Walker - Calif St SF

The man is somewhat lost with the busy cityscape. I like the use of shadow and sunlight, getting the man in a better position needs some help, try getting close and maybe lower to put him higher in the skyline.

The fire should be the main focus in the shot. If the road is blocked you can walk through some front yards to get a better angle.

Good action image, would like to see more of the dogs face. Nice camera placement looking into the approaching dog.

## 10. Early Morning Roundup

Also a nice image, not as balanced as the first image.

## 11. Fort\_Ord\_Mud\_Run\_participant

All the kids have great expressions at the start of the race. You have a lot of space at the top of the image that could be cropped down.

## 12. Hanging netting to prevent a slide

Very dramatic, now the longer shot is used well to establish the risk at hand. The placement of workers from top to bottom of hillside also works well.

## 13. Hurricane\_Irene\_flood\_damage,\_Quechee,\_VT

After the first glance you start to pick up the total amount of damage on and around the bridge. The image keeps the viewer interested. Nice.
