#### 1. African Woman

A very well done portrait, I love how the hand helps tell a story. What is she looking at? What is she thinking? I like the color saturation, great composition.

## 2. Ashley

I like the look of the vignette, and how the color is slightly de-saturated which adds to the look of an old fashion portrait. I do find the highlight in the upper right distracting.

## 3. Baby Giraffe Portrait

A very nice animal portrait, nice detail throughout the baby giraffe, I like how it is cropped. Lighting is great, nice catch light in the eye and it is very sharp.

#### 4. Best Friends

I really like the story that this portrait is telling. It has very good color saturation and the out of focus background (your Bokeh) color is very nice. I would like to see his entire hand however.

#### 5. Elk - Koi Reflections

A very sharp well exposed portrait. I like the idea of the reflections on the sunglasses.

### 6. Erin

Nicely done studio portrait. I like how the girl is lit, the colors are soft and pleasing. This picture reminds me of an old fashioned photo, a perfect example of Rembrandt lighting. Well done.

## 7. Hi Key Kari

A very nice black and white portrait, I like the vignette effect and the emotion that this picture shows. However, the back of the right shoulder looks a little washed out.

### 8. Italian Pride

I like the color saturation, a great candid portrait. The only thing that bothers me is the hair going across the face, but still I like it.

### 9. Jack

A great outdoor portrait, it is very sharp with good saturation. It is very hard to shoot water photos with a fill flash or did you use a reflector. I might crop a little more on the right so he is a little more off center.

#### 10.John

I like the picture that is a frame within the frame, nice affect. The photo has very good lighting and color saturation, while being taken inside what looks like an airplane.

## 11.Lighthouse Dan

This portrait tells a great story. I like how the light keeper is posed to the side of the lighthouse. I might have cropped it at the fence as his blue pants pulls your eyes down, but well done.

# 12. Male Elephant Seal Portrait

A well-done animal portrait, it very sharp and well exposed with no loss of detail throughout the picture. I like how it is cropped. He is a bit ugly don't you think?

#### 13.Maria

A very nicely done studio portrait, I like how the hair has excellent texture and the skin is soft with sharp eyes. Very nice.

#### 14.Mr. Ed

Another great animal portrait- looks like Mr. Ed is eating and still wants to talk. Everything that needs to be in focus is, it is nicely cropped.

#### 19. The Biker

Heeeyy lets go for a ride. I really like the composition and lighting. With this big macho dude looking at me, I would like his face not quite so soft.

## 20. The Candyman Can

This is a great candid portrait. I really like the color saturation- it makes the photo pop out. I like how it is tightly cropped. Your background has a beautiful Bokeh. Great depth of field.

#### 21.The Gaze

I like the lighting and the pose, but the face and eyes appear to be slightly out of focus.

## 22. The Girl with the Strange Eyes

I like the color of the background with the girl's red hair. Your exposure is very good which was hard to get right with a very wide range in the exposure between the light skin and dark dress. And yes the eyes are a bit strange. She kind of gives me the creeps.
