Nature:

1. An Osprey (Pandion haliaetus) lightens the load in preparation for flight – Poop in the air? Would be of limited interest in the commercial marketplace.

2. Alert Juvenile blue heron siblings-Ardea Herodias – Good shot, but needs sharpening to try to overcome the out of focus.

3. Bumblebee pollinating bush lupine (Bombus bitarius) – Beautiful. 3rd prize

4. Budding Devil's Club (Oplopanax horridus) in Sitka, Alaska -

5. Charlock Mustard (Sinapis arvensis) – Ok, but could be a brighter yellow?

6. Gopher Snake (Pituophis catenifer) – If you darken behind the head on the body in back, the head becomes stronger.

7. Hovering Allen's Hummingbird (Selasphorus sasin) - Beautiful. – 1st prize

8. Forster's Tern with Catch – Excellent. - 2nd prize

9. Honey bee pollinating flannel bush blossom (Apis) – Darkening the wings will help us feel more comfortable with this bee seemingly suspended in space.

10. Geat egret-ardea alba-with mating plumage collecting nesting materials – I would brighten the eye and the green feathers to draw our eye there more.

11. Green Darner in Flight – Good shot. If you darken the yellow background a little the darner becomes stronger. - HM

12. Humpback breach – Nice splash, but overall feels awkward.

13. Japanese Kingfisher (Alcedo atthis) uses menacing body language to discourage other birds trying to feed in its space - Beautiful. Excellent. HM

14. Nectaring Western Tiger Swallowtail (P. rutulus) – Very nice.

15. Juvenile California Condor (Gymnogyps californianus) – Good shot. However, cropping the wing of the other bird and the bottom, will make it stronger.

16. Probing for crustaceans – We can't see the fish, which is needed to make it a strong picture. It looks like it is getting a drink of water.

17. Live Tiger Moth (apantesis proxima) -

18. Reflections In The Eye Of A Red Tailed Hawk - Good

19. Scratching Ground Squirrel (Otospermophilus beecheyi) – Weird position, distracting.

20. Male Peregrine Falcon (Falco Peregrinus) – Good, but would be better if the feathers were in focus.

21. The Eyes of the Eagle (Haliaeetus leucocephalus) – Excellent. Should darken the orange in upper right corner, though.

22. Spotted Moray in Crevice – Too bright. Darken the coral to highlight the moray.

23. The Endangered Tidestroms Lupine (Lupinus tidestromii) - Well done. Very nice. - HM

24. Well camouflaged american alligator-Alligator mississippiensis – Lightening the eyes and darkening the green foreground will make it more powerful.

25. Western gull-Larus occidentalis-feeds on beached giant squid-Architeuthis – Doesn't come together.

26. Snowy Egret Landing – Well done.

27. Tule Elk with Calf- very nicely done. Perhaps darken the white tails a bit. Good.

1. Aloe Zebrina – Good composition. Could perhaps use a bit more brightening of the middle of the flower. – 3rd prize

2. Hispanic Lady in a Straw Hat – God job. I would brighten the glint in her eyes a bit. That if what we are looking at, and I want to see into her soul. She is nice and not threatening, and I want to feel closer to her. Darken the top of the frame above the hat with a gradient. – 2nd prize

3. Stainless spiral – Nice combining the feel of b&w and color at the same time. Good balance in shading. Darken the fabric it is sitting on. We don't care what it is on, and it distracts from the subtleties on the metal. – 1st prize

4. Waiting for the storm – The title doesn't really match the picture well. The wood blocks us seeing the storm. The storm doesn't look like a storm. You could make the clouds more contrasty, darker and lightning the respective areas. So much of the lower fence isn't so interesting, it is the top we are looking at. There is a lot you can do with the sky.

5. When is the train coming – The pregnant woman is distracting and pulls us away from the girl. Darken all the lighter areas so we are pulled into the girl more.
