- **01.** American Black Oystercatcher with just-hatched chick still with egg shell (Haematopus bachmani) Second Place Good nature story, unusual capture, Rocks in front could be toned down.
- **02. Black Forest Landscape** Not really a nature image. Building and such in the background.
- **03.** Blue heron (Ardea herodias) captures prey in heavy moss Third Place Tells a great story. Could be cropped a bit.
- **04. Bobcat in Morning Light (Lynx Rufus)** Honorable mention Very clean image with nice light.
- **05. Great Egret Ardea alba hunts Pocket Gopher Geomyidae** Honorable Mention Good story and great capture. Loss of detail on the egret.
- **06.** Honey Bee (Apis mellifera) pollinating yellow flowers Good exposure, bee is a bit centered.
- **07. Julia butterfly (Dryas iulia)** Good exposure, body of butterfly is not sharp.
- **08.** Lined Shore Crab (Pachygrapsus crassipes), Weston Beach, Pt. Lobos Too tight and hard to read.
- **09.** Lunar Eclipse nearing half completion Moon should be sharp. Very small in the image.
- **10. Osprey (Pandion haliaetus) with Fish Tail** First Place Good composition, very sharp, clean background. A very good nature image.
- **11. Small tidal eddy patterns in sand at Asilomar Beach** Nice pictorial image. The nature story is not easily discerned.
- **12. Spinning on the Railing** Hand of man. Hard to read.
- **13. Staring down Photog** Need more of a nature title. Good composition. Lacks sharpness.
- **14.** Tarantula (Arachnida theraphosidae) raises abdomen and hair in warning Tarantula is sharp. Hard to read. Contrasty lighting.

- **15. Turkish Towel (red Alga) Chondracanthus** exasperates Nice Colors, good composition.
- **16.** Wary Pelican Nice detail on the pelican. The head of the bird is a bit blown out. Needs more base and less on the top.
- **17. Western Honey Bees (Apis mellifera)** find plenty of pollen in pumpkin blossom Domestic blossom. The bees are not sharp.
- **18.** Western side-blotched lizard (Uta stansburiana) blends in to surroundings Good nature story, harsh Lighting and the tail of the lizard is cut off.
