


Serene, easy to live with, but might do with a focal point. Cloud reflection are very soothing.





Jerry Heisel Neat shot - Would prefer background fish to be sharper. Hammerhead shadow is threatening as it should be.




24 - The Lone Cypress.jpg *Carol Silveira* A timeless photo - especially without the vertical pattern overlay. Good clouds ****


