01 – Autumn Colors.jpg

Using contrasting colors (red and green) really helps to accentuate the colors of the foliage. The dirt in the background orientates the viewer and gives a sense of scale. Arrangement reminiscent of a birds' nest.

02 - Big Bunch of Baskets.jpg

Wonderful lighting and composition. They both (lighting & composition) give enough spatial property to exist individually & contribute to the composition.

03 – Birdless cages.jpg

Very interesting item. Intricate designs. Could creating an abstract or a "macro" study of the baskets aid in highlighting their design?

04 - Bottled.jpg

The image has great symmetry & balance.

05 - Cave altar.jpg

Lighting very dark & dramatic, aids in the feeling – cold & cavelike. Is there camera movement or focus shift? Think about headspace – the statue / monument on top.

I imagine this was extremely difficult to light and photograph. Nice work on above, and no reflection. If title didn't say glass, I would have thought this was really ice!

Wonderful moment of passage of time. Resembles a barren landscape. The monochromatic pallet emphasize the kelp, & it's progression of time & movement. It is not in control of its destiny, rather along for the ride.

08 - Kelp on wet sand.jpg

The reflection of the kelp captures the beauty & it's organic shape.
